Guidelines for LRA Dump Areas

Non-Hazardous, Biodegradable Material Disposal Procedures

When disposing of *small* (Ranger load) amounts of tree branches, leaves, and clean dirt, ensure that all materials are biodegradable and free from contaminants such as plastics, lumber, chemicals, or non-organic waste. Only natural tree/bush foliage, and soil should be dumped to maintain environmental safety.

- Dump materials in designated areas, identified by signs, not in general landfill areas.
- Remove any non-biodegradable items, such as plastic bags, wire, or synthetic ties, before disposal.
- Ensure branches and leaves are not treated with pesticides or preservatives.
- These areas are for small amounts of material. Larger amounts need to be removed from LRA property.
- Report any contamination or improper dumping to the LRA Board.
- NO dumping in the area reserved for silt.
- All material to be dumped must be from Lake property – No outside dumping!

By adhering to these guidelines, you help promote responsible environmental stewardship and support healthy soil and plant ecosystems.
